

General Rules

%Kansas Quirks: Middle and High School

All USB drives and other removable storage must have an official identification label. Official identification labels are provided during check-in. It is strongly recommended that USB Drives, and other removable storage, be placed in an envelope and attached to the portfolio, in semi-permanent manner. All removable storage devices are returned to chapters at the conclusion of the conference.

General Rules apply to all events and are on pages 5-8 of the Middle and High School Guides

General Rule D.4. Middle and High School Guides

For all entries that require physical documentation materials (comprising a “portfolio”) secured in a clear front report cover. See image below.



%Kansas Quirk:

Physical portfolios should be submitted as stated in event guides **AND** uploaded to Judge Pro as noted in the Early/Digital submission sections of the Handbook for the Kansas TSA State Conference.

General Rule D.7 (MS guide) and D.6. (HS guide):

Participants must provide—and bring to the test site—two (2) pencils (sharpened standard #2/HB grade with an eraser, or #2 mechanical with an eraser) for any competition that involves the use of a pencil (e.g., for taking a written test, for producing required sketches).

General Rule E.1. Middle and High School Guides:

For all applicable competitive events, written work – for citations or references – Middle School submissions must follow one professional citation style of their choice; High School submissions must follow the Modern Language Association (MLA) style.

VEX Robotics Competition

To be an official VEX team and participate in an official VEX or TSA VEX all teams must be officially registered on the www.robotevents.com
